One of our school priorities this year is to continue to build a positive working relationship with parents and carers. We hope to achieve this by keeping you informed about the methods that we use to support your child's learning.


You may remember that we invited you to complete a parent/carer survey earlier in the academic year. One of the priorities that you feedback to us, via the survey, was ensuring that your child had homework that supported their learning and progress. As a result, we are going to be introducing homework tasks that aim to address the individual gaps in their knowledge and understanding for each subject. Teachers will be using in-class assessments to identify the personal learning needs of your child and set homework to address them.

Where possible, your child will be bringing their subject workbook home to complete and record their homework. This will also provide you with the opportunity to see the work they have been completing in class.

In order for us to make sure that we get the process working in the correct way, we will be trialling this new way of working with Year 11 and 13 in the first instance. We will then be reviewing the process and make improvement or alternations, if required, before setting homework for all students in this way.
